


Long Term Plan for English 2023/2024

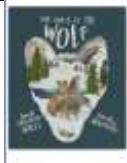
At Beechwood Primary School, we aim to provide learning opportunities in English which encourage children:

- to use grammar and punctuation accurately, together with spelling and cursive handwriting;
- to improve the planning, drafting and editing of their written work;
- to develop in pupils the confidence, desire and ability to express their views and opinions both orally and in writing.

Activities are the planned, weaving the RESPECT values throughout each session. Learning Challenges are introduced in most sessions, encouraging children to take an active role in their learning, but also to help learning becoming sticky!
