At Beechwood Primary School, we aim to provide learning opportunities in Geography which encourage children to:

- *Develop and nurture inquisitive minds and to equip the children with skills in order to find answers to their questions.*

Activities are the planned, weaving the RESPECT values throughout each session. Learning Challenges are introduced in most sessions, encouraging children to take an active role in their learning, but also to help learning becoming sticky!
