Attendance & Punctuality

The minimum expected attendance at school is 96%. Well done to Chestnut Class who had 100% attendance last week. Chestnut will have cookies, juice and extra play for doing so well with their attendance. Due to Covid, attendance across the school has dropped significantly. Please remember that the new guidance means that children can return to school once they have had a negative LFT on days 5 and 6. If it is still positive, keep testing until there are two consecutive negative tests or Day 10 (whichever is sooner).

School <u>starts at 8.45am</u> so children need to be in their classrooms before this time. There are lots of children arriving between 8.52am and 9.00am each morning and all of these sessions are being marked as 'late' by the safeguarding lead. Please try and help your child to be punctual each day.

Beechwood Bagel Bar

We have recently secured funding to enable the school to provide a free bagel to pupils each morning before the start of school. Bagels will be available on the junior playground between 8.35 and 8.45 each morning. There is no charge for these and all pupils are welcome to come and get a free breakfast.
